### 1 Draper Museum

Thursdays | 12 – 4:30 pm | FREE  
555 Technology Square

Explore artifacts and displays celebrating Draper's role in biomedical technology, national security, and lunar explorations, including the Apollo missions. Founded at MIT in 1933, today Draper engineers solutions to the nation's toughest problems for government, industry, and academia.

### 2 Broad Discovery Center

Learn how researchers at the Broad Institute of MIT and Harvard are uncovering the causes of cancer, infectious diseases, psychiatric conditions, and more. Featuring videos and interactive displays, you can explore the center on your own or book a tour.

### 3 Koch Institute Public Gallery

View award-winning biomedical images from current research projects and personal reflections from researchers throughout the MIT network. The galleries are housed in the first floor lobby of the Koch Institute for Integrative Cancer Research, a National Cancer Institute accelerating the discovery of new ways to detect, treat, and prevent cancer.
