Future of (how we) Work

This monthly, topical meeting is for people working in Kendall Square companies to discuss the challenges and opportunities happening in our workplaces. Meetings focus on providing spaces to participants to share workplace challenges as well as opportunities to engage in collaborative, realtime problem solving and benchmarking.

Inclusion Drives Innovation

Inclusion Drives Innovation is a 10 week, SHRM accredited professional development program. The program focuses on building anti-racist organizations by providing foundational learning to individuals and guiding a team through equity-centered action planning.

This programming allows the growing community of Inclusion Drives Innovation alum to support and connect with each other as they continue to advance their organization's anti-racist efforts. Alumni programming is centered around education, building connections, and collaborative problemsolving.

14th Annual Meeting

This celebratory event spotlights the successes of our innovation ecosystem as it pioneers solutions to global problems and leads the charge on the future of work. Open to anyone interested in attending, our Annual Meeting draws employees from across Metro Boston.

Kendall Square Challenge

This signature KSA event provides our members the opportunity to reconnect with Kendall Square, each other, and the community. Teams spend an afternoon competing in support of five local nonprofits culminating in a celebration to present checks to the winners and the presentation of the Kendall Cup to the first place finisher. This event provides an unparalleled day of team building, friendly competition and philanthropy.

We're on a journey to understand how best to identify solutions to Kendall's greatest challenges by connecting with our City leaders and the broader Cambridge community. We keep the Kendall community apprised of what's happening in Cambridge City government, advocate on its behalf, and engage the City Council and community organizations to work towards innovative solutions for our most pressing societal issues.

Government and Community Affairs

We help members build and sustain a positive working relationship with the City of Cambridge, state agencies, community nonprofits, schools, and neighborhood associations to strengthen partnerships and educate the broader community about the benefits and value of Kendall Square.

<u>Transportation ADVANCE</u>

Kendall grew up on the MBTA Red Line and is a model for transit oriented development where major employers are property owners who are actively engaged in making sure that we have sustainable and practical transportation options. The KSA educates our community about our transportation challenges, advocates for improvements, and supports members in taking direct action.

Restaurant and Retail

We keep Kendall Square vibrant by working with local restaurant owners and small business owners as we share news and updates from state and local government about support, and advocate on behalf of their needs to local elected officials.

Community Impact Working Group

This group brings together corporate social responsibility leaders to create an agenda for enhancing equity, sustainability and corporate engagement in Cambridge. Together, these leaders share organizational learning between Kendall businesses and the Cambridge community in order to ensure efforts are effective, aligned and responsive to the City's needs.
