Thoughtful Programming + Events That Connect Us

We believe that the “bump factor”—the “human collisions” that happen in Kendall—fuel innovation. We bring people together around programming and events that are thought-provoking, impactful, and fun, so you keep coming back.

FUTURE OF (HOW WE) WORK PROGRAM. Monthly, topical meetings connect decision-makers and leaders from companies across Kendall to focus on how we work today, and how to positively shape the workplace of the future. Together, we learn from experts and one another, sharing ideas and practices that work, and establishing collaborative solutions and benchmarks.

INCLUSION DRIVES INNOVATION (IDI) PROGRAM.

Ten-week professional development program that focuses on providing foundational learning in anti-racism and equity, applying frameworks to organizational systems and culture, and guiding teams through equity-centered organizational action planning. Offered twice per year. IDI alumni convene regularly to move this essential work forward.

KENDALL ORIENTATION. Monthly interactive gatherings introduce newcomers to Kendall. Part guided tour, part history lesson, and a fun way to meet new colleagues from across Kendall in spaces and places you didn't even know existed.

KENDALL TOURS. KSA team members host private group tours on request, showing you the best of Kendall featuring privately owned public spaces (POPS), landmark buildings and world-renowned organizations, plus the best places to eat and drink.

KENDALL SQUARE CHALLENGE. An unparalleled day of team building, philanthropy, and friendly competition. Fifty or so teams from organizations who care about Kendall and the community gather to compete in a series of physical and mental challenges, all in support of local nonprofits. Then we celebrate.

ANNUAL MEETING CELEBRATION.

An opportunity to honor the success of our innovation ecosystem in pioneering solutions to global problems. This special evening is open to anyone and draws people from across the region.

MEMBER SOCIALS. Casual gatherings in fun, new Kendall spaces offer a way for members to mix and mingle.

SPEAKER SERIES. Leaders from around Kendall share their thoughts in virtual or in person conversations discussing cutting edge topics ranging from sustainability to smart cities and the newest in tech and life sciences.

We connect with government, business, nonprofits, community leaders and a range of organizations, at the city, state, regional level and beyond. We keep our members informed, and we engage to develop shared positions. Together, we advocate for innovative solutions for our most pressing societal issues.

In addition to Government and Community relations, our Working Groups include:

COMMUNITY IMPACT. We bring corporate social responsibility leaders together to elevate equity, sustainability and corporate engagement in Cambridge, collectively, effectively, and in alignment with the City's needs.

TRANSPORTATION. We study transportation, glean insight from our members, the MBTA transit experts, and our partners in state and local government more. We keep our members informed, we advocate for improvements, and we support members' direct action. Having grown up along the Red Line, Kendall is a model for transit-oriented development where major employers and property owners actively support sustainable and practical transportation options.

RESTAURANT & RETAIL. We work with local restaurant owners and small business owners to keep Kendall Square lively and vibrant. We share news and updates from state and local government, and we advocate on behalf of their needs to local elected officials.
